As our project reaches its conclusion, here is a summary of what is in each building, and improvements to look out for

The Buildings

Te Korōria (which means the Glory)



At street height (170 Karori Road)

- Café and Hospitality space
- Soft play for Children
- Full Kitchen
- Lift between levels
- Deck overlooking courtyard.

Lower level

- Staff office and kitchen
- Meeting room / Godly Play room
- Storage Room
- Grass courtyard



Te Whare o Mere / The House of Mary



Extension to former hall

- SMASH office and store room
- ECEC Breakout room
- Two counselling rooms and waiting area
- ECEC Storage
- Car parking (on site of demolished Parish hall)
- Refreshed rooms including the Kōwhai / Yellow room (old supper room/activity room), and Waiporoporo room /purple room (old SMASH office)

Carparking

- Pick up and Drop off for ECEC and SMASH outside Te Whare o Mere / House of Mary for 5 cars
- Disabled parking available
- Carparking along south side of Church for 10 cars

The Vicarage



Current offices will be converted back to a residence to operate as a rental property.

Changes to take note of



- Te Korōria (our third community enterprise) will run a Café, Soft Play and Counselling services.
- Opening 6 May
- Invite people to join you at the café and soft play

- Visitors can park along south side of St Mary's and short stay parks



- Access from Karori Road from the 8 May
- Will have access to the soft play on agreed days
- Operating as usual
- Parents can park in short stay car park directly outside Te Whare o Mere or in the new parks by St Mary's Church
- Take the lift of the stairs down to the centre



- The office and Junior programme operates from Te Whare o Mere / House of Mary from the 8th May
- SMASH will continue to use St Mary's Church during the week, depending on numbers of children
- Will have access to soft play as part of the programme
- Parents can park in short stay car park directly outside Te Whare o Mere or in the new parks by St Mary's Church



- Offices move to Te Korōria building. You can take the lift or the stairs to visit us from the 8th May
- All meetings currently held in prayer room will be in the new meeting room (Kikorangi / Blue) room
- Impact and Crossfire will use Kōwhai / Yellow and Waiporoporo /Purple rooms
- The Collective uses Kowhai room
- Sunday Youth in Kikorangi /Blue room
- Use of Playgarden unchanged
- Weekday visitors please park on the South Side of the Church. Disabled parking spot available outside Te Whare o Mere and Te Korōria.
